Historic Tyneside Business Supports “Hero” Seafarers During Coronavirus Crisis

NEWCASTLE-based shipping and marine insurer, North P&I Club (North), has lent its support to a number of local and international charities, drawing attention to the welfare of seafarers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

As shipping is vital part of the international supply chain keeping our shelves stocked, many crews remain at sea, unable to see their loved ones, until restrictions ease.
